






Largest Consumers of Steel Scrap, 2012 & 2013




Ferrous scrap exports from the United States alone surged from less than 5 million metric tons in 2000 to more than 22 million metric tons in 2011.

Ferrous scrap exported from all countries surged more than 70 percent higher in just over a decade.


Global ferrous scrap exports exceeded 100 million metric tons for the first time in 2010 and continued to climb higher through 2012.




