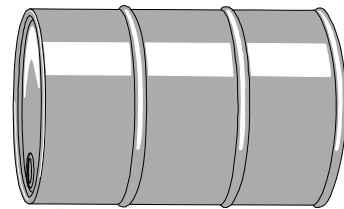


# *F*or *Y*our *D*riving

Most scrap recyclers have restrictions on handling any container that might have held hazardous materials or pressure. Drivers are the first line of defense to make sure these potentially dangerous materials don't enter their vehicle or the scrap yard.

Make sure you **check out your load before heading down the road**. Any drums, cylinders or other containers that have the diamond-shaped hazard warning labels should be avoided. Ask the customer what it is, if the container is empty, and what the hazards might be from residue that could remain.

Drivers need to be **hazard aware!**
