

## Ask Dave



**Q.** *Our safety guy said I should not climb on top of the rolloff box, but I need to inspect the load at the customer's site before I haul it. What should I do?*

**A.** The safety guy is right about not climbing on top of the container. It's probably an OSHA violation if you are over 4-feet off the ground, and it's just not safe. A lot of drivers have had serious injuries when falling off a container. Many drivers carry a small ladder on their truck so that they can inspect the load without risking a nasty fall. Always look at the load when the box is on the ground too.
