## Expect the Unexpected in Highway Construction Zones

According to the National Safety Council, over 100 road construction workers are killed in construction zones each year. In addition, more than 700 people, most of them motorists, are killed annually and nearly 37,000 people are injured each year in work zone-related vehicle crashes. Here are some safe driving tips for managing construction zones:

### **Manage your Speed:**

- Slow down
- Follow posted speed limits
- Don't resume normal speed until you see road signs indicating it's safe to do so.

### **Manage your Space:**

- Leave room
- Don't pass on the shoulder
- Leave yourself an out
- Watch out for tailgaters

### **Manage your Stress:**

- Keep your cool
- Pay attention
- Expect delays
