The Points You Can't Afford to Collect

Under the Compliance Safety Accountability (CSA) enforcement program, you're on-road safety violations will cost you points on your CSA scores, making it more likely that you and/or your employer will face a penalty. The violations listed below all carry the highest possible severity weight (10 points) in the CSA scoring system.

| FMCSA Section | Description | CSA Scoring Category |
|-----------------|---|----------------------|
| Parts 173 & 177 | Hazardous materials load securement | HM Compliance |
| 386.72 | Violating an Imminent Hazard Out of Service Order (OOS) Order | Driver Fitness |
| 392.2 | Reckless Driving | Unsafe Driving |
| 392.2 | Speeding 15 mph or more, or speeding in a construction zone | Unsafe Driving |
| 392.3 | Driving while fatigue | HOS Compliance |
| 392.4 | Use or possession of drugs | Drugs & Alcohol |
| 392.5 | Violating an OOS Order related to alcohol use | Drugs & Alcohol |
| 392.63 | Pushing or towing a loaded bus | Vehicle Maintenance |
| 392.80 | Texting while driving | Unsafe Driving |
| 392.82 | Using a hand-held cell phone while driving | Unsafe Driving |
| 395.13 | Driving after being placed out of service | HOS Compliance |
| 396.9 | Operating an out-of-service vehicle | Vehicle Maintenance |

Did you know? These aren't the only costly infractions. There are more than 250 safety violations that carry 7 points are more under CSA. ***Don't let these high-point violations lead to a low point in your career!***
